I have pleasure to inform that TERI has been empanelled by the ITEC (Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation programme) /Special Commonwealth Assistance for Africa Programme (SCAAP) of the Government of India. As a part of this, TERI has scheduled to conduct a three-week international training programme on “Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency” from 25th March to 12th April, 2019 at TERI's campus at Gwal Pahari, Gurgaon.

The training course has been structured so as to help the participants in developing an understanding of various RE technologies along with measures to achieve energy conservation and techniques for improvement of efficiency. On RE side, the course would cover solar energy, wind power, biomass gasifier-based systems and small hydro. Besides, there would be good scope for discussions around government policies, rural energy issues and demand side management aspects.
