Topic: Sun shining across the oceans: supporting the blue economy through solar

The International Solar Alliance's Asia and the Pacific group stretches across both the Indian and the Pacific oceans – from Saudi Arabia across to the Pacific islands. What unites this group – apart from their commitment to solar energy – is the ocean.

The World Bank defines the blue economy as 'the sustainable use of ocean resources for economic growth, improved livelihoods and jobs, and ocean ecosystem health'. Renewable energy – including solar – supports this agenda. Solar has a significant role to play, supporting both industry – through large-scale floating solar, solar ferries, and storage of fishing catches – and individuals – for instance, through solar desalination plants.

This session will explore these issues in depth.
